UNOPPOSED MOTION TO CONTINUE SENTENCING

COMES NOW the defendant, Preston Pinkett, by counsel, and files this Motion to continue the sentencing in this matter until June 19, 2009. Defense counsel has consulted with counsel for the government, who does not oppose this Motion. In support of this Motion, Mr. Pinkett states as follows:

1. On December 2, 2009, Mr. Pinkett entered a plea of guilty to a one count criminal information charging conspiracy to commit mail fraud. At that time, sentencing was set for March 6, 2009.
2. On February 5, 2009, the Court granted a joint motion to reschedule the sentencing for May 1, 2009, to permit additional time to conduct debriefings of Mr. Pinkett and because of the complexity of the underlying conduct.
3. The parties believe that these meetings may have a significant impact on the sentencing proceeding. However, scheduling of additional meetings has been delayed in part because of the assigned prosecutor's involvement in the trial of *United States v. Woolf, et al.*, 08-CR-12.
